

Seven Devils Resort Club
Fishing Rules and Regulations

Revised (May, 2021)

- **ANYONE FISHING IN THE RESORT CLUB PRIVATE LAKE (DEVILS LAKE) ACKNOWLEDGES AND ACCEPTS ANY AND ALL RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH SUCH ACTIVITY, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO FISHING FROM LAKE BANKS, DOCKS, OR BOATS. AS A RESULT, ANYONE FISHING IN DEVILS LAKE HOLDS HARMLESS THE SEVEN DEVILS RESORT CLUB, BOARD OF DIRECTORS, AND MEMBERS FOR ANY AND ALL INJURIES OR DAMAGES RESULTING FROM PARTICIPATING IN SUCH FISHING ACTIVITIES.**
- Fishing badges will be issued annually, and are valid only for the fishing season of the year issued.
- Fishing in the private lake is restricted to Resort Club Members in good standing (who purchased an annual license) their immediate family, and house guests. Club Member must be present and shall display a valid badge in a manner to be clearly visible at all times.
- Club members are responsible for the behavior and adherence to these rules and regulations by their guests.
- Devils Lake is a private lake. State of North Carolina fishing licenses are not required.
- Costs: \$40.00 per badge for Associate Members which allows Associate members and their guests to fish.
- Costs: Fishing is free for Regular Members and allows Regular members and their guests to fish. Regular members must apply each year to receive their new badges at no cost.

Fishing Season

- Fishing is open year round. New licenses are issued each year on the Club Opening date.

Fish Catch and Keep Limits

- Catch and release fishing is encouraged to help maintain and sustain fish population and a healthy lake ecosystem.
- Maximum of two (2) fish per day for each fisherman.
- Kept fish must be ten (10) inches or longer in length.
- Injured fish are counted in this daily limit, whether or not the injured fish is kept.

- Seasonal limit is 12 fish per badge per season (honor system).
- Each fisherman with a valid license is limited to one (1) pole, one(1) line, and one(1) hook.
- ALL hooks must be barbless.
- Treble hooks are not permitted.
- Baits-artificial baits are permitted. Live baits are permitted, except for minnows, frogs and worms.
- No night fishing.

CONTINUED ON REVERSE SIDE

Violations

- Unauthorized fishing shall be considered a violation of Trespass Laws.
- Violators shall be subject to prosecution under the applicable local and state laws accordingly.

Miscellaneous

- All members purchasing a fishing license are required to list their vehicles (make, model and tag number) on the membership application.
- Fishing Rules and Regulation enforcement shall be accomplished by all Seven Devils Resort Club Members.
- Minor violations shall generate a warning. Repeated minor violations and all serious violations may result in loss of fishing license and privileges (at the discretion of the Resort Board of Directors).
